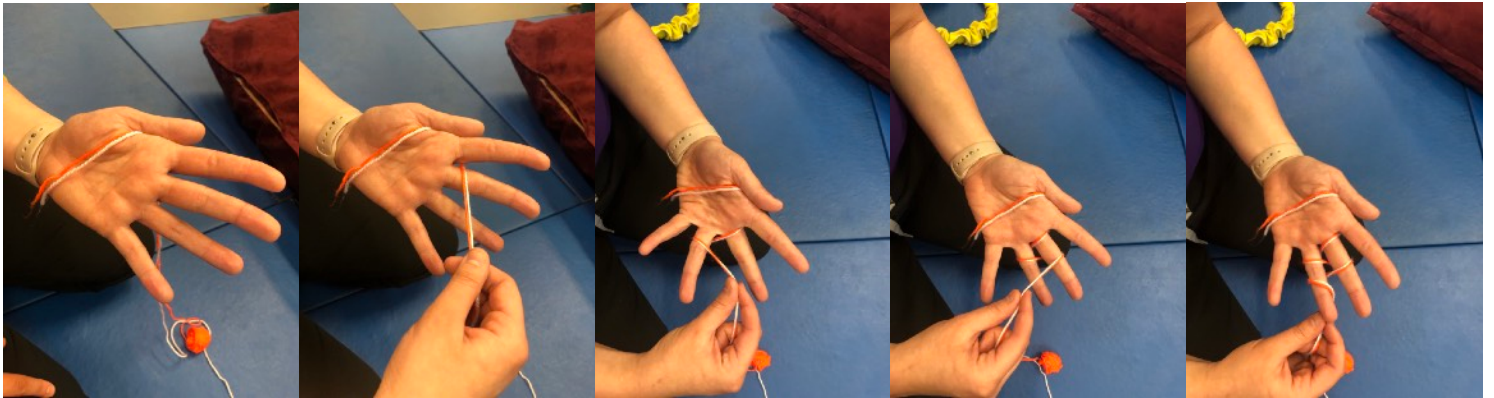
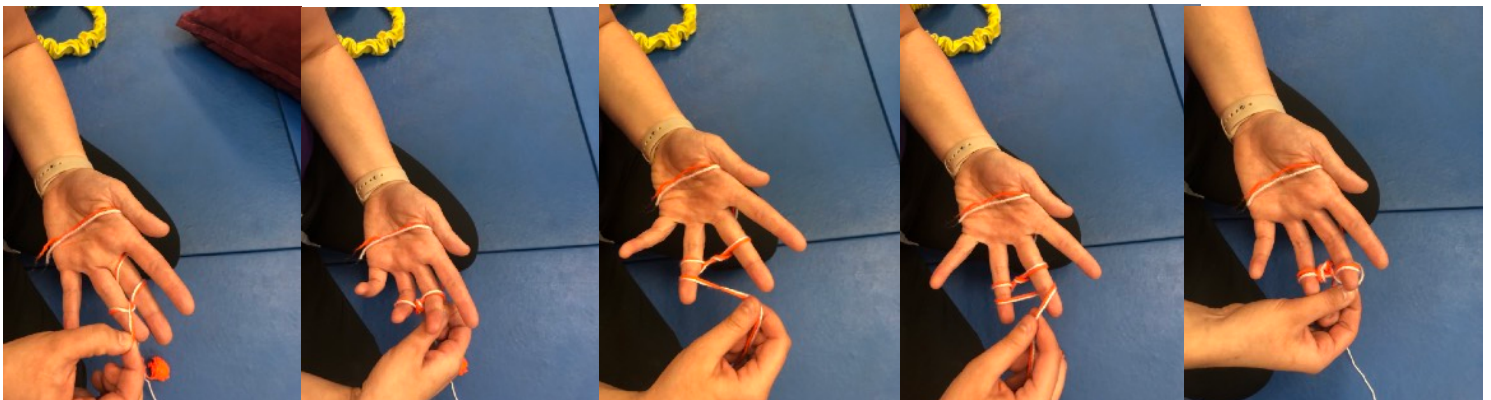


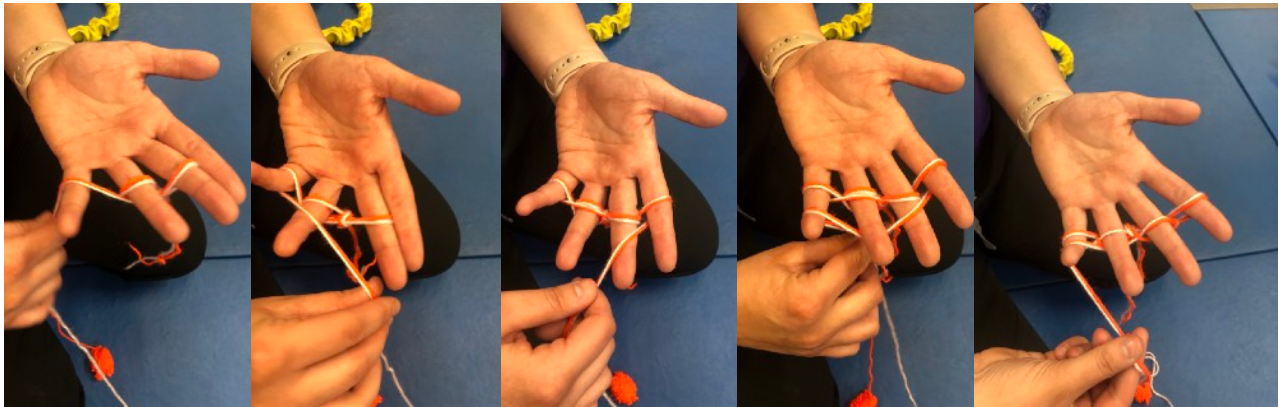
Finger Knitting: Snake



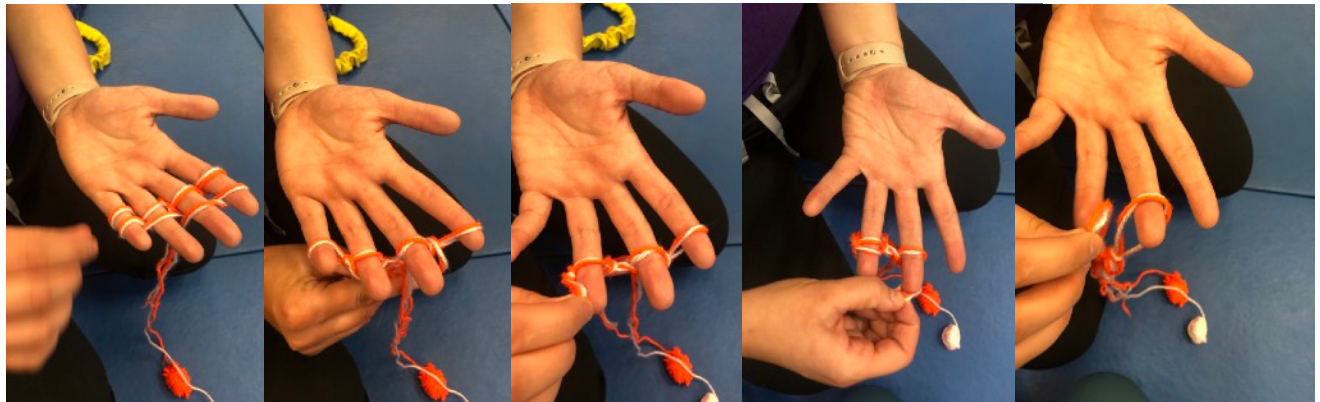
- Hold two pieces of yarn in between thumb and index finger
- Weave yarn behind index finger and lace between middle finger and ring finger
- You should have two sets of yarn on middle finger and ring finger



- Pull bottom set of yarn over and off ring finger and middle finger
- Weave around ring finger, behind and around middle finger to create two sets of yarn on middle finger and ring finger
- Repeat these steps until desired length for body of snake is achieved



- Now expand to four fingers for wider head of snake
- Bring string behind ring finger and wrap around pinky, weave in front and behind remaining three fingers
- Ring finger and middle finger should have two set of yarn, pull bottom set of yarn over and off ring finger and middle finger
- Wrap around pinky and weave through all four fingers



- All four fingers should have two sets of yarn
- Pull bottom set of yarn over and off all four fingers, repeat three times
- Move pinky finger loop to ring finger
- Move index finger loop to middle finger
- Move ring finger to middle finger
- Pull bottom set of yarn over and off middle finger
- Remove loop from middle finger, hold loop and pull yarn to a tight knot.
- Add tongue and eyes!
